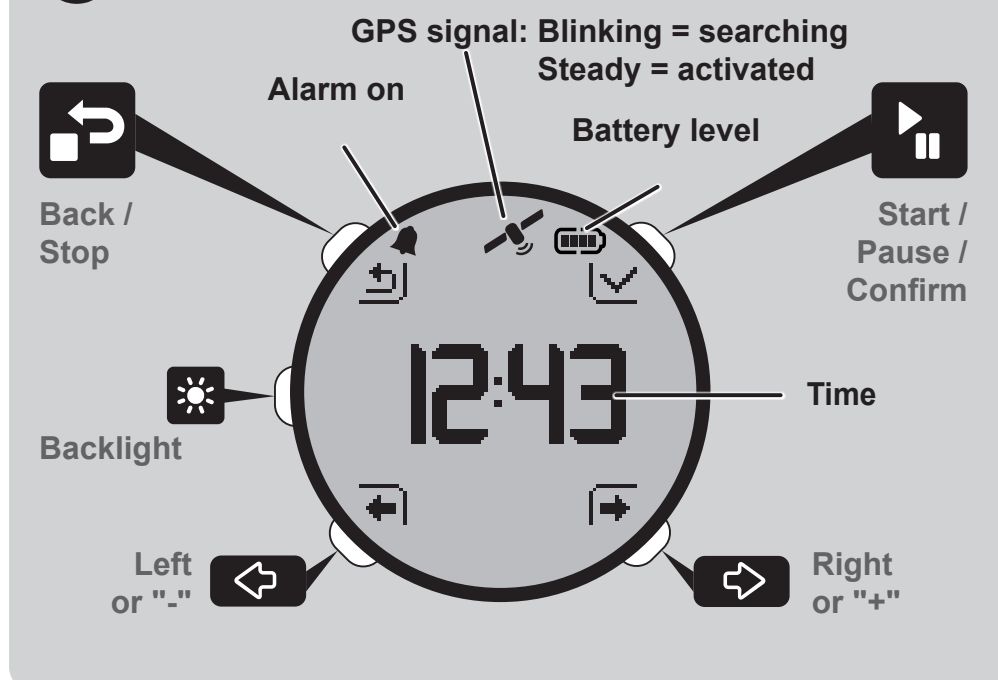

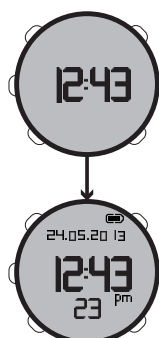


1 Intuitive guide










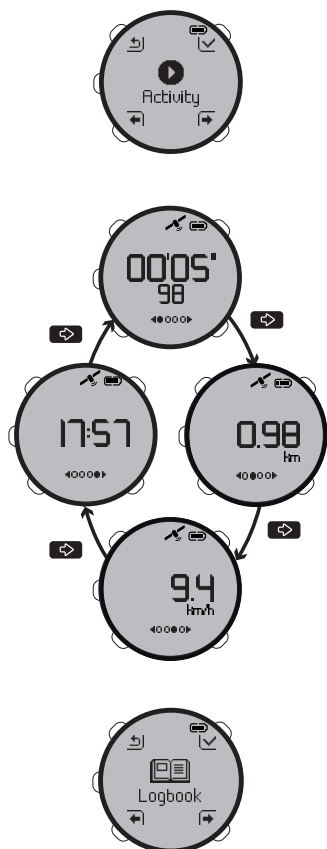
2 First use

- To begin ▶ Press and hold 
- Follow the intuitive onscreen guide, see **1**, to set the language (FR, EN, DE, ES, IT, PT, NL, ZH), date, time, and units.



3 "TIME" Mode

- To access the Activity / Journal / Settings Mode ▶ Press 
- ▶ Choose mode:  or 
- ▶ Confirm: 
- To display date and battery level ▶ Press  or  or 












4 "ACTIVITY" Mode

- To access ACTIVITY Mode ► see ③

The watch will begin searching for a GPS signal automatically (duration: 2 min. max.):

- Move to a clear, open space away from buildings.
- Do not move while the signal is being detected.

NOTE: To stop the search, press .

5 "JOURNAL" Mode



- To access JOURNAL Mode ► see ③

- To enter into the journal ► Press , then **1** or **2**

- 1** To explore the journal ► Press 

- To navigate between recordings ► Press  or , then **A** or **B**

- A** ■ To see the details of a recording ► Press 

- To navigate between data (length, distance*, average speed*) ► Press  or 

- B** ■ To delete a recording ► Press  or , then 

- Confirm ► Press 

- 2** To delete the journal ► Press  or , then 

- Confirm ► Press 

(*) Only for outdoor activities.

6 "SETTINGS" Mode

- To access the settings ► see ③

- Choose an item to set ► Press  or 

- Confirm the selection ► Press 

- Follow the intuitive onscreen guide, see ①, for setting the data.

ALARM = sets the alarm time and turns the alarm ON and OFF

TIME = sets the time

DATE = sets the date

SOUND = turns the sound on and off (except the alarm)

UNITS = sets the units (cm/kg or inch/lb)

LANGUAGE = sets the language

ABOUT = firmware version and serial number



7 To turn off the alarm

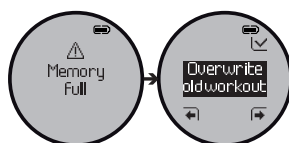
- To turn off the alarm ► Press any key (except ).

NOTE: The alarm sound will turn off but the alarm itself will remain activated.

8 To turn off the watch

- During an activity ► Press and hold 
► Press  to confirm
- From any of the other screens ► Press and hold  until the watch turns off.

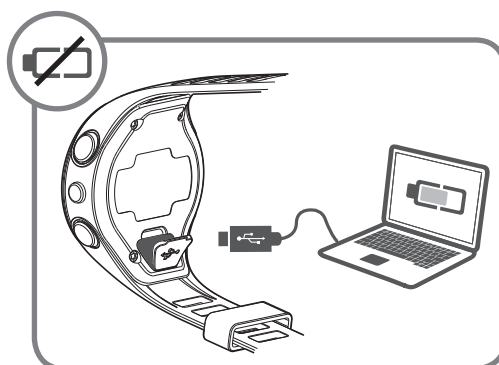
